RE-SKILLING THE VALLEY

RE-SURFACING:

Approval has been given for resurfacing the section of the A134 Great Horkesley between approx Green Lane and the Post Office and this work is programmed to be carried out at night commencing 28th September with a road closure. The duration is ten weekday nights but may finish sooner depending on progress. The diversion route will be the B1508 into Suffolk and a diversion route has been agreed with Suffolk County Council via Sudbury. Local residential traffic will be able to gain access via West Bergholt and Boxted as appropriate.
